

NEIGHBORHOOD SPORTS GRILLE TEXAS HOLD'EM TOURNAMENT

Thank you for playing in our seasonal Texas Hold'em Tournament. This winter we've had an ever increasing crowd as we've strived to improve our program for your enjoyment. We accept and listen to all input to improve our program.

Simple Neighborhood Sports Grille rules:

Please be respectful to other players. We have a family oriented mixed crowd. We also have a mixture of experienced, knowledgeable, and beginner players. Neighborhood Grille invites everybody at every level of experience to sit and join our tournament.

Please be respectful of the help. They are there to serve you, but it gets busy and your patience is requested. If you establish a tab, please pay it before you leave. Don't forget to tip your server.

Texas Hold'em Rules:

We generally abide by WSOP, WPT or Casino House Rules.

We have (3) standing rules regarding players not seated when it's their turn.

- 1) If dealer sees them and communicates with them that it's their turn, we'll accept the delay. Example: If returning from the bathroom or finishing a meal at a table, we'll wait for them to get seated.
- 2) If they're not in view (they may be in the bathroom) at the moment it's their turn, the hand is mucked.
- 3) If the player is elsewhere in the bar for multiple hands, we'll alert them when they're in the big blind. Other than that, their hand is mucked whether we can see them or not.

The game starts at or about 7:00pm. We accept new players until 8:00pm. New players are seated according to table balance.

Raises are double the previous bet. Raises must be called. No double betting.

Dealers play and generally are given "comps" or chips. The amount and frequency at the discretion of the tournament director to attract quality dealers and equality of play.

Blinds are raised at predetermined intervals. Clock may be stopped for various reasons and will be announced to the best of our abilities. Breaks are also set. If you're not seated following break your hand may be mucked, in the blinds or not.

Tournament play Tuesdays and Thursdays

Points are awarded as follows

Tournament runs 12 weeks, 24 games. Points are accumulated and the top players are invited to play in the Championship. The Championship will be as follows:

Thursday, February 17 – Top 27 playoff. Game starts at 7:00pm. Game ends when there are 9 players remaining. Players are given an equal amount of chips, there are no rebuys or add-ons.

Sunday, February 20 – Final Table (9). Game starts at 1:00pm. Players are given an equal amount of chips., There are no rebuys or add-ons. Game ends when one player has all the chips.
